

# Zone 2 Championship Autocross Series

## Concept

Create a traveling series consisting of one autocross event in each participating region. These events would be conducted using each region's existing classing and rules set. Participants would be awarded points based on their finishing position in the class they run. At the end of the series awards would be presented to participants based on their totals.

## Goals

To promote inter-region camaraderie through friendly competition. To foster a growing sense of unity within Zone 2. To generate increased participation in regional autocross events.

## Details

Each region that hosts autocross events will nominate one of their regular event dates to be part of the series. The Zone will determine the calendar. This may require some negotiations to eliminate conflicts.

Once the final calendar is established each region will submit a copy of it's rules, event schedule, directions to the venue and registration details (costs, online links, deadlines, etc.) The Zone will then publish the complete schedule and advertise and promote the series.

## FAQ

**Our region does not host autocross events. Can we participate?** Yes. Any member of any region in Zone 2 is eligible. They should sign up for each participating event. Your region can promote the series in newsletters, on web sites and at meetings.

**How does a member indicate they wish to compete in the series?** At any time prior to the series last event the member can just drop an email to the zone series chairman indicating their desire to participate.

**Putting on an autocross event is hard enough. We don't want to add to the workload of our autocross organizers. What extra work will they have to do?**

The great thing about the design of the series is there is very, very little extra work. No special scoring or registration is required. You need to do 4 things:

- Determine the date for your series event from your already existing schedule.
- Send rules, event schedule, directions to the venue and registration details to the zone series chairman

- After the event send a copy of the results of the series event to the zone series chairman
- Advertise and promote the series

**How will the scoring work?** For each series participant at each event they will be awarded points based on their finishing position within their class:

- 1st place - 10 points
- 2nd place - 8 points
- 3rd place - 6 points
- 4th place - 4 points
- 5th place - 2 points
- below 5th place - 1 point

To be eligible for a series trophy, a participant must have participated in a minimum of 50% of events on the calendar (rounded down).

All events attended add to a participant's points but one event will be dropped if the participant competes in all series events. (i.e. If there are 8 series events only the scores in 7 of those events will count.)

In the event of a points tie, the participant with the most 1st places will win (if 1st place finishes are equal then compare 2nd places, etc.)

**Are there any classes that are not eligible?** Since availability of novice classes varies between regions, novice class is not eligible.
